



## **SILVA BAY OUTSTATION RULES AND REGULATIONS**

This document governs the use of the NYC's dock at Silva Bay Resort, and will be available for reference in the yellow NYC Club Check-in Box on that dock.

Our outstation at Silva Bay Resort and Marina consists of 80 feet on D Dock, slip 48. This facility is available for members year round.

- Moorage can be reserved through our 'Online Sliva Bay Outstation Reservation Calendar', available on our website, under 'Cruising' then 'Outstations. Place your name, vessel name and vessel length on the date to reserve. Depending on the size of the vessel(s), there should be room for 2 vessels per night.
- Moorage may be restricted on occasion to accommodate NYC Cruising events, at which 'free' moorage would be distributed equitably.
- Vessels are required to fly the NYC burgee at the dock.
- Rafting is allowed as long as there is no restriction of traffic areas. There is room for rafting; rafting would be first come/first served. Members in reserved spots can and should expect and be hospitable to fellow members rafting alongside.
- Reserved moorage will be considered invalid after 1700 hrs, and it will be 1<sup>st</sup> come, 1<sup>st</sup> served after that time of day.
- Two nights is the limit for one stay; members should give up their spots to new arrivals after that time.
- This moorage is for members only. Reciprocal agreements do not apply to this moorage.
- Registration required immediately upon arrival, on the registration sheet, in the yellow NYC Club Check-in Box; documenting date of visit, member's name, boat name and length.
- Registration is also required at the Silva Bay Resort Office, at your earliest opportunity. Members using power are responsible for this cost, payable to the Silva Bay resort upon registration. This slip is monitored by the Silva Bay Marina staff.
- Vessels are required to carry 3<sup>rd</sup> party liability insurance to the value of \$1M.
- Tenders should be stored in a manner that minimizes overall length and does not prevent rafting by other members.
- Children under 16 must wear a life jacket. Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Pets must be on a leash when on the dock, owners are responsible to clean up after their pets.
- Members should always act in a way that reflects well on our club, and is not detrimental to safety or the quiet enjoyment of others.
