

Notice of Race

Nanaimo Yacht Club Singlehand Championship 2018

- 1. This race will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020, this Notice of Race, and the Nanaimo Yacht Club (NYC) General Sailing Instructions 2018.
- 2. PFD's must be worn by participants during the length of the race.
- 3. Autohelm, Autotiller, or Windvane devices maybe use during the course of the race, this changes RRS rule 52.
- 4. Racing will be open to NYC member and non member keel boats and multihulls. Boats with a valid PHRF-NW or PHRF-BC certificate are eligible for flying sails divisions; PHRF-BC ratings will be adjusted to PHRF-NW ratings. Boats without valid PHRF certificates may enter the "No Flying Sails" division, the race committee will assign a rating valid for the race only. Any boats without a valid PHRF-NW certificate are requested to contact the duty officer stating their intent to race prior to race day to allow time for rating assignment.
- 5. Boats wishing to enter must complete registration before racing. Registration may be completed at the NYC clubhouse lower floor prior to the skippers meeting. Please provide proof of insurance valid for racing with a coverage of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence 3rd party liability. Registration includes a waiver of liability which must be completed and signed.
- 6. Fee for the race is \$10.00. Boats may pay a fee of \$50.00 for all NYC club series races for 2018 including Winter Series, Spring Series, Day and A Bit, Singlehand Championship, Fall Series and Jack and Jill.
- 7. The Singlehand Championship race date is Saturday, July 21, 2018. Skippers meeting is 0900 on the steps of the NYC clubhouse lower floor. General sailing instructions will be available at the skippers meeting or on line at www.nanaimoyc.ca. First warning signal is 1025. The course will be set at the skippers meeting and posted on the official notice board, lower floor NYC clubhouse.
- 8. Divisions will be announced at the skippers meeting on race day, based on entries.
- 9. The start will be from Satellite Reef marker and Mail Order Bride.
- 10. Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each division at the annual race awards ceremony.
