



## Notice of Race

### Nanaimo Yacht Club Spring Series 2016

1. This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016, this Notice of Race, and NYC General Sailing Instructions. The NYC General Sailing Instructions will be available at the skippers meeting and are available on line at [www.nanaimoyc.ca](http://www.nanaimoyc.ca).
2. Racing will be open to NYC member and non member keel boats and multihulls. Boats with current PHRF-NW certificates are eligible for PHRF divisions. Boats with a PHRF-BC rating will be accepted in the PHRF divisions, and ratings will be adjusted to conform to PHRF-NW. Boats without rating certificates may enter the Cruising Class division and the race committee will assign a rating valid for the series only.
3. Boats wishing to enter must complete registration before racing. Registration may be completed at the NYC clubhouse lower floor prior to the skippers meeting. Please provide proof of insurance valid for racing with a coverage of \$1,000,000 per occurrence 3<sup>rd</sup> party liability. Registration includes a waiver of liability which must be completed and signed.
4. Fee for each race day is \$10.00. Boats may pay a fee of \$100.00 for all NYC club series races for 2016 including Spring Series, Day and A Bit, Singlehanded Championship, Fall Series and Jack and Jill.
5. Spring Series race days are February 21, March 6, March 20, April 3 and April 17, 2016. Skippers meeting is 0900 each race day on the steps of the NYC clubhouse lower floor. First warning signal is 1025 each race day. One or more races will be held each day.
6. Divisions will be announced at the skippers meeting, race day one, based on entries.
7. The race area will be the outer Nanaimo Harbour using marks described in the NYC General Sailing Instructions 2016.
8. First place in each division will have the boat and skipper's name engraved on the perpetual trophy for that division.
