1. RULES

1.1 The Snake Island Nanaimo Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, 2013 to 2017.

1.2 PIYA Category III will be observed for PHRF division and those yachts participating in the single-handed, double-handed and cruising divisions.

1.3 PIYA Category IV will be observed for one-design classes or safety regulations particular to that class.

1.4 One-design class rules will apply if five or more boats in each class compete.

2. **ADVERTISING** - Shall be restricted to Category C.

3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

3.1 This regatta is open to all area sailing boats that have a valid PHRF rating (see section 4 for details if your boat is not so rated). See section 7 for entry procedures and early entry discounts.

3.2 Separate racing areas will be provided for one-design, PHRF fleets and single handed/cruiser fleets.

3.3 Longer courses are anticipated for larger boats in the PHRF fleet.

3.4 New for this year, we welcome single-handers, double-handers, family cruisers and white sails competitors to race in their own area.

3.5 Proof of liability insurance of \$1,000,000 may be requested at the time of registration.

4. PHRF-NW MEMBERSHIP

4.1 Membership in PHRF-NW or PHRF-BC is required for each boat racing PHRF, family cruiser and single and double-handed and white sail divisions. If a PHRF membership or boat rating is not established, one will be provided with a weekend PHRF-NW membership for \$15.

5. **SCORING** - Time-on-time-method of scoring will be used for all divisions, except one-design divisions. Low-point scoring will be used as in RRS Appendix A
6. **FEES** - The entry fee for all classes is \$75 per boat. The entry fee includes dinner ticket for the skipper, t-shirt, sponsor swag and welcome information.
7. **SCHEDULE OF RACING EVENTS AND REGISTRATION**
 - 7.1 Friday, June 28: Registration and check-in at NYC 1600 to 2000.
 - 7.2 Saturday, June 29: Registration for latecomers continues Saturday, 0700 to 0800.
 - 7.3 Skippers Meeting: 0830 Saturday
 - 7.4 Saturday Race Day One with all regatta participants starting in Nanaimo Harbour. Warning signal for the first start is 0955.
 - 7.5 Sunday, June 30: Race Day Two, followed by Awards Ceremony including presentation of the CUTTYSARK Cup.
 - 7.6 **ADVANCE REGISTRATION** - Competitors may register in advance by completing the Event Registration Form available on the Nanaimo Yacht Club Website.
 - 7.7 **Early Registration Bonus:** Entry Fee is reduced to \$60 if received by midnight, June 1, 2013.
 - 7.8 **Special to non-NYC boats:** The first 25 registrants not from the Nanaimo Yacht Club will receive an extra dinner ticket.
8. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** - The sailing instructions will be available at registration and on the web by June 1, 2013.
9. **PRIZES** - Prizes will be awarded to competitors placing first through third in all divisions including the awarding of the CUTTYSARK Cup.
