1. RULES

1.1 The Snake Island Nanaimo Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, 2013 to 2016.

1.2 PIYA Category Nearshore will be observed for PHRF divisions.

1.3 PIYA Category Nearshore will be observed for one-design classes or safety regulations particular to that class.

1.4 One-design class rules will apply to boats in one-design divisions.

1.5 The rules of PHRF-NW will apply to handicap divisions.

2. **ADVERTISING** - Shall be restricted to Category C.

3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

3.1 This regatta is open to all keelboats, multihulls and one design classes eligible for a PHRF-NW rating.

3.2 One-design divisions will be created if an adequate number of boats apply to compete in each division. The registration committee will determine how many boats may comprise a division.

3.3 Boats with a PHRF-BC rating will be accepted. Ratings will be adjusted to confirm to PHRF-NW.

3.4 Boats without a rating certificate may apply for a single-event certificate from PHRFNW for a fee of \$15 at the registration desk.

3.5 Proof of liability insurance coverage of \$1,000,000 per event is required.

4. Racing Area and Courses

4.1 Racing will take place in the outer Nanaimo Harbour and nearby waters.

4.2 Separate areas will be defined for PHRF fleets and OD fleets.

4.3 Longer courses may be provided to fast PHRF classes.

5. SCORING

5.1 RRS Appendix A low-point scoring will be used.

5.2 PHRF-NW divisions will be scored using the time-on-time formula.

6. **FEES** - The entry fee for all classes is \$85 per boat. Entry fees are payable via the Nanaimo Yacht Club - SIN Website, remitted by PayPal. The entry fee includes weekend meal wristband providing two breakfasts & one dinner for the skipper, sponsor swag and welcome information.

7. SCHEDULE OF RACING EVENTS AND REGISTRATION

a. Friday, June 27: Registration and check-in at NYC 1600 to 2000. "Sark it to Me" party on the docks. \$5 burgers are available.

b. Saturday, June 28: Registration for latecomers continues Saturday, 0700 to 0800.

c. Skippers Meeting: 0830 Saturday, June 28.

d. Saturday June 28: Race Day One. Fleets are to make their way to their respective starting locations for a 10:25 warning.

e. Sunday, June 29: Race Day Two. Fleets are to make their way to their respective starting locations for a 10:25 warning. Followed by Awards Ceremony including presentation of the Cutty Sark Cup.

f. **ADVANCE REGISTRATION** - Competitors may register and remit fees via PayPal in advance by completing the Event Registration Form available on the Nanaimo Yacht Club SIN Website.

g. **Early Registration Bonus:** Entry Fee is reduced to \$70 if received by midnight, June 1, 2014. You may remit by PayPal.

h. **NEW FOR 2014:** Weekend meal wristbands are available for \$20, providing two breakfasts and one dinner. They may be prepaid with your registration.

Amendment number one to the SIN NOR:

Article 4.2, Separate racing areas will be defined for PHRF fleets and OD fleets.

Is changed to read:

Article 4.2 There will be one starting area for PHRF Fleets and One Design fleets.

Rational for this change: Racing area "B," off Neck Point Park, will not be used for the PHRF fleet this year.

Amendment number two to the SIN NOR:

Article 7 (a), Friday, June 27: Registration and check-in at NYC 1600 to 2000. the "Sark it to Me" party on the docks. \$5 burgers are available.

Is changed to read:

Article 7 (a), Friday, June 27: Registration and check-in at NYC 1600 to 2000. The "Sark it to Me" party will be at the NYC Clubhouse. \$5 burgers are available.
